

WFW ASESORA EN LA FINANCIACIÓN DEL PARQUE EÓLICO “ESTRELLADA” DE 50MW EN URUGUAY

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Watson Farley & Williams (“WFW”) ha asesorado a Banco Santander, S.A. y Banco Santander S.A. (Uruguay) en la financiación del proyecto eólico “Estrellada”, parque eólico en operación desde 2015 de 50MW de potencia instalada, situado en Cerro Largo, Uruguay. La operación se cerró el 14 de diciembre de 2018.

El parque es propiedad de Atlantica Yield tras la adquisición del mismo a Enel Green Power de forma simultánea a la operación de financiación.

El proyecto cuenta con un contrato de compraventa de energía (PPA) suscrito entre la sociedad proyecto titular del parque y Administración Nacional de Usinas y Transmisiones Eléctricas (UTE), entidad íntegramente participada por el estado uruguayo.

Con esta adquisición, Atlantica Yield sigue incrementando su presencia en el sector uruguayo elevando a 150W su potencia eólica en el país.

El equipo especialista en derecho financiero de WFW, liderado por Rodrigo Berasategui, socio, ha contado con Jose María Anarte, asociado sénior.
