

WFW CONSEILLE EURONEXT POUR L'ACQUISITION DE 78% DU CAPITAL DE COMMCISE

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Le cabinet d'avocats international Watson Farley & Williams (« WFW ») a conseillé Euronext, principale place boursière pan-européenne, dans le cadre de l'acquisition à hauteur de 78% de Commcise Software Limited (« Commcise »), auprès de ses fondateurs, pour un montant initial de 27 millions de livres sterling. Commcise est une société spécialisée dans les solutions de services informatiques (SaaS) permettant l'évaluation et la gestion de commissions pour les services financiers.
