

# HOW TO FIND US

---

## RAIL

## UNDERGROUND / METRO / SUBWAY

## ROAD

## AIR

It is possible to hire a black cab at any of the following airports. You can find detailed information about travel to/from airports near London by visiting the [websites listed in the next column.](#)

### London City Airport

Take the London City Airport Docklands Light Railway (DLR) to Bank Station. This journey takes approximately 25 minutes. Change to London Underground, taking the Central/red line one stop east to Liverpool Street.

### London Gatwick Airport

Take the Gatwick Express to London Victoria. This journey takes approximately 30 minutes. Change to London Underground, taking the Circle/yellow line east to Liverpool Street station.

### London Heathrow Airport

Take the Heathrow Express to London Paddington. This journey takes approximately 15 minutes. Change to London Underground, taking a Hammersmith & City/pink line train or a Circle/yellow line train going east to Liverpool Street station.

### London Luton Airport

Take the shuttle bus from outside the terminal at Bay 1 to Luton Airport Parkway station. Then take a train to St. Pancras International train station. Change to London Underground, taking the Metropolitan/purple line, Circle/yellow line or Hammersmith & City/pink line east bound. Exit at Liverpool Street station.

## ON FOOT FROM LIVERPOOL STREET STATION

Approximately a five minute walk. In the main station concourse, walk in the direction of the lower platform numbers.

Keep walking in this direction, you will pass some escalators on your left and in front of you there will be a small parade of shops. A Boots store will be in front of you to the right.

Turn right immediately before the Boots store and follow the walkway (you will pass branches of Toni and Guy and Starbucks). Once outside follow the path for approximately 100 metres and take the steps on the right. You are now on Exchange Square.

Walk past the White Horse pub and take the steps on your left back down to street level. You are now on Appold Street. Cross the road and turn left, the entrance to our London office (located in the Earl Place building) is the next door on your right.

## ON FOOT FROM MOORGATE STATION

Approximately a 10 minute walk. Exit the underground station and proceed on to Moorgate, the main road. Head north, away from London Metropolitan University, and towards Barclays bank and Marks & Spencer (M&S).

Turn right when you reach Finsbury Square, there is an Itsu sushi restaurant on the corner. Follow this road into Finsbury Avenue. Continue in this direction, the road will merge into Sun Street.

After the Starbucks on Sun Street the road curves to the left and at the corner it joins Appold Street. Our London office is in the next building, Earl Place.
