

WFW NEL FINANZIAMENTO CONCESSO DA CRÉDIT AGRICOLE A FRATELLI NERI S.P.A.

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Watson Farley & Williams (“WFW”) ha assistito Crédit Agricole Italia S.p.A. nell’ambito di una operazione di finanziamento navale in favore di Fratelli Neri S.p.A., facente parte del Gruppo Neri attivo nel settore del rimorchio portuale e servizi marittimi connessi, volta a finanziare la costruzione del rimorchiatore denominato “ROMITO”, costruito presso il cantiere olandese DAMEN.

La nuova unità andrà ad incrementare la flotta del Gruppo Neri che dal 1895, anno in cui il gruppo ha iniziato ad operare nel settore marittimo con mezzi propri, ad oggi può contare su 40 mezzi, principalmente rimorchiatori portuali, dei Terminali LNG e petroliferi, rimorchiatori di salvataggio, costieri ed in mare aperto, così offrendo i propri servizi ad armatori, società petrolifere e di energia, agenti marittimi, autorità marittime e portuali.

Il finanziamento è stato già interamente erogato a copertura dei pagamenti concordati a stato avanzamento lavori con il cantiere olandese.

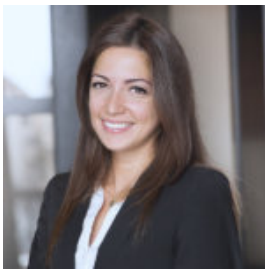
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
