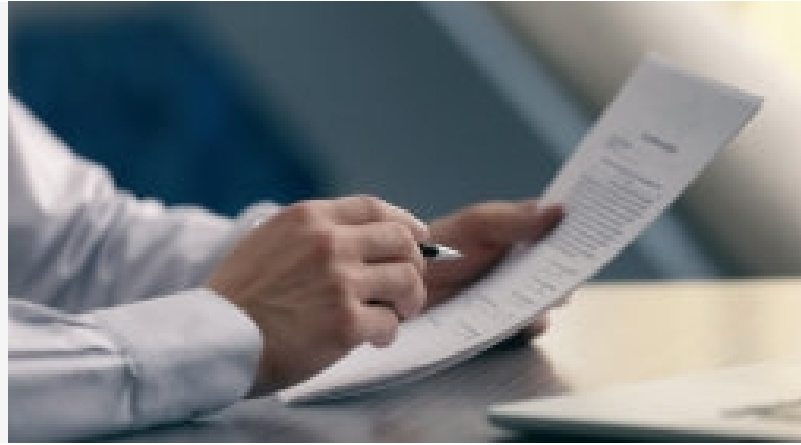


WFW CONSEILLE ATE DANS LA NÉGOCIATION D'UN ACCORD DE PARTENARIAT AVEC DALKIA POUR LE FINANCEMENT DE PROJETS DE TRANSITION ÉNERGÉTIQUE

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Le cabinet d'avocats international Watson Farley & Williams (« WFW ») a conseillé Amundi Transition Énergétique (« ATE ») dans le cadre de la négociation et de la conclusion d'un accord de partenariat avec Dalkia pour faciliter le développement des réseaux de chaleur renouvelable au service des territoires français.

Cet accord permettra de proposer aux collectivités territoriales des solutions innovantes et durables conjuguant l'expertise et le savoir-faire de Dalkia, et un montage original de financement compétitif s'appuyant sur les compétences d'Amundi en matière d'investissements en infrastructures.
