

WFW ASESORA A NORTHLEAF EN LA ADQUISICIÓN Y FINANCIACIÓN EN UNA PLANTA FOTOVOLTAICA DE 493MW

Watson Farley & Williams (“WFW”) ha asesorado a Northleaf Capital Partners (Canada) Ltd (“Northleaf”) en la adquisición a Cobra Concesiones de las participaciones de la sociedad propietaria del Proyecto Mula, una planta fotovoltaica *ready-to-build* de 493MW, en Murcia. Asesoramos adicionalmente en la financiación el Proyecto otorgada por Banco Sabadell, Bankia y BNP Paribas.

Cuando esté operativo, en junio de 2019, Mula se convertirá en la planta fotovoltaica sin subsidio más grande de Europa. Los MWs del Proyecto forman parte de la capacidad fotovoltaica adjudicada en la tercera subasta de renovables organizada por el Gobierno español.

Northleaf Capital Partners es un fondo de inversión global privado e independiente que gestiona más de 10.000 millones de dólares en planes de pensiones públicos, de empresas y otro tipo de instituciones como fundaciones, dotaciones, entidades financieras y *family office*.
