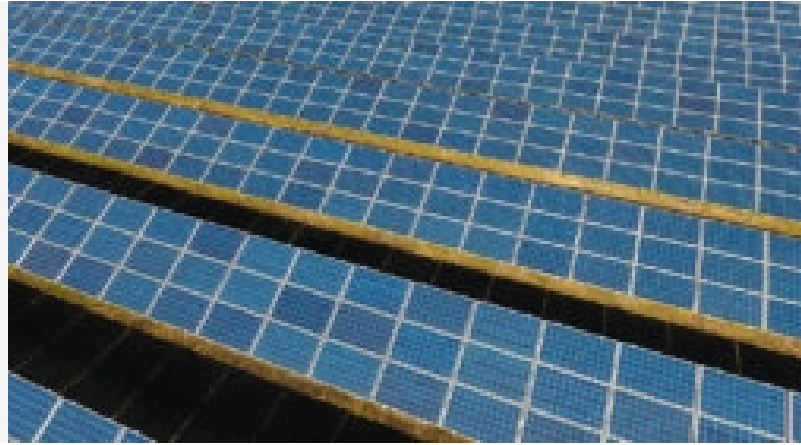


WFW ASESORA A EVERWOOD EN LA FINANCIACIÓN DE LA PLANTA FOTOVOLTAICA CARTUJA DE 50 MW

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Watson Farley & Williams ("WFW") ha asesorado a Everwood Capital ("Everwood") en la financiación por €25m otorgada por Liberbank de la planta fotovoltaica Cartuja de 50 MW, actualmente en fase de construcción. La operación se cerró el pasado 31 de diciembre.

La planta fotovoltaica, desarrollada por Abei Energy, está localizada en Cádiz y operativa durante 2021. Se trata de la segunda planta *merchant* de Everwood. La financiación representa un apalancamiento del 62% del proyecto.

Everwood es la gestora de fondos de inversión española líder en la construcción de nuevas plantas fotovoltaicas *merchant*. Everwood gestiona hoy en día su cuarto fondo de más de €300m y su quinto fondo, que todavía está en proceso de levantamiento de capital, y que tiene un importe objetivo de €500m.

El equipo de WFW involucrado en el asesoramiento legal de la negociación de la financiación ha sido liderado por Jose María Anarte, socio de Financiero, trabajando con Jacobo Hermidas, asociado sénior.

Jose María comenta: "Ha sido un gran placer asesorar a Everwood en esta operación. Vemos menos proyectos *merchant* ahora en el sector pero la confianza que brinda Liberbank, en su primera financiación con esa modalidad en España, augura un futuro de oportunidades. Nuestro equipo, líder en financiación de proyectos en España asesora, de nuevo, a los principales actores del mercado."

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
