

WFW BERÄT NORD/LB BEI BRÜCKENFINANZIERUNG EINES POLNISCHEN WINDPROJEKTPORTFOLIOS

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Watson Farley & Williams ("WFW") hat die Norddeutsche Landesbank Girozentrale ("NORD/LB") bei der Brückenfinanzierung eines Windparkportfolios in Polen in Höhe von 45,5 Mio. Euro beraten, das vom dänischen Entwickler European Energy entwickelt und gebaut wird. Das Portfolio besteht aus fünf in Polen gelegenen Windparks mit einer Gesamtleistung von 44.675 MW.
