

WFW CONSEILLE TECHNIP SUR LE FINANCEMENT DU NAVIRE « DEEP DISCOVERER » À HAUTEUR DE £70.5M

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Le cabinet d'avocats Watson Farley & Williams ("**WFW**") a conseillé Technip UK Limited ("**Technip**") sur le financement du nouveau navire de support de plongée m.v. « Deep Discoverer » à hauteur de 70,5 millions de livres sterling et arrangé par Crédit Industriel et Commercial ("**CIC**") et BNP Paribas. Ce navire a été construit par le Groupe Vard AS en Norvège.

Le navire a été acquis par une filiale de CIC. Le financement a en partie été effectué sous la forme d'un crédit-bail au terme duquel le navire a été pris en location par Technip UK Limited.

L'équipe de WFW était dirigée en financement par les associées Alexia Russell et Laurence Martinez-Bellet, accompagnées des collaboratrices Natasha Seel et Konstantina Kyprianidou en droit anglais, ainsi que du collaborateur senior Christophe Garcia et de la collaboratrice Sophie Morin sur les aspects de droit français.
