

WFW BERÄT KfW IPEX-BANK GMBH BEI DER PROJEKTFINANZIERUNG DES SOLARPARKS „LA GRANJA SOLAR“ IN CHILE

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Die internationale Wirtschaftskanzlei Watson Farley & Williams („WFW“) hat die KfW IPEX-Bank GmbH bei der US\$91m Finanzierung des Solarparkprojekts „La Granja Solar“ beraten. Das Projekt befindet sich im Norden Chiles, in der Nähe von Pozo Almonte.

Die Kreditdokumentation wurde im Dezember 2018 unterzeichnet. Der Solarpark gehört mittelbar Solarpack Corporación Tecnológica, S.A., Getxo, Spanien, das das Projekt auch selbst entwickelt hat und errichten wird. Nach Fertigstellung wird es eine Gesamtleistung von 123 MWp erbringen.
