

WATSON FARLEY & WILLIAMS CONSEILLE BAYWA R.E. SUR L'ACQUISITION DU DÉVELOPPEUR ENERPOLE

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Le cabinet d'avocats international Watson Farley & Williams (WFW) a accompagné le développeur BayWa r.e., leader mondial du secteur des énergies renouvelables, sur l'acquisition du développeur éolien et solaire Enerpole, poursuivant ainsi sa forte croissance en France.

Le portefeuille de projets d'Enerpole totalise une puissance de 600 MW, dont près de 300 MW solaires et 300 MW éoliens. Cette opération permet à BayWa r.e. de se doter d'une septième agence française et de renforcer sa présence en Occitanie où elle exploite déjà 5 parcs solaires. Son portefeuille de projets en développement en France atteint désormais 2,2 GW (1 GW éoliens et 1,2 GW solaires).

Créée en 2005 à Carcassonne, Enerpole figure parmi les pionniers du développement des énergies renouvelables et a longtemps été un partenaire privilégié de BayWa r.e.

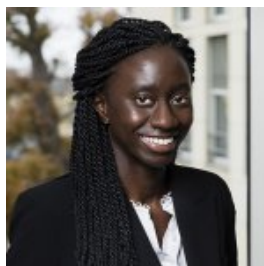
