

WFW ASESORA A OPDENERGY EN UN PPA DE 750 MW CON UNA UTILITY EUROPEA CON GRADO DE INVERSIÓN

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Watson Farley & Williams (“WFW”) ha asesorado al productor español de energía sostenible Opdenergy en la negociación y ejecución de un acuerdo de compraventa de energía (PPA) de 750 MW a diez años con una *utility* europea con grado de inversión, uno de los mayores PPA bilaterales firmados en Europa hasta la fecha.

El PPA abarca 17 proyectos en las regiones españolas de Teruel, Zaragoza, Badajoz, Cuenca y Valladolid, que en conjunto generarán energía suficiente para abastecer a más de 450.000 hogares al año.

Opdenergy es un productor independiente de energía sostenible consolidado y totalmente integrado, con más de 15 años de experiencia en la producción de energía solar fotovoltaica y eólica terrestre.
