

WFW BERÄT SCHRODERS GREENCOAT BEIM ERWERB EINES WEITEREN ANTEILS AM WINDPARK BUTENDIEK

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Watson Farley & Williams („WFW“) hat Schroders Greencoat beim Erwerb eines weiteren Anteils von 22,5 Prozent am Offshore-Windpark Butendiek („Butendiek“) durch Fonds, die der Mandant berät oder managt, beraten. Der Offshore-Windpark Butendiek, rund 35 Kilometer vor der deutschen Nordseeküste gelegen, besteht aus 80 Windkraftanlagen mit einer Gesamtnennleistung von 288 MW.

WFW hatte Greencoat Renewables PLC bereits beim Erwerb eines 22,5-prozentigen Beteiligung an diesem Projekt im Januar 2023 von Marguerite Pantheon beraten.
