

WFW NEL FINANZIAMENTO CONCESSO DA CRÉDIT AGRICOLE AD AMORETTI

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Watson Farley & Williams (“WFW”) ha assistito Crédit Agricole Italia nell’ambito di due operazioni di finanziamento navali in favore di Marittima Emiliana S.p.A., facente parte del gruppo Amoretti Armatori di Parma, volte a finanziare la costruzione di due navi chimichiere da 4,500 dwt presso il cantiere della Repubblica Popolare Cinese Ningbo Xinle Shipbuilding, specializzato nella costruzione di navi cisterna.

Le due nuove unità andranno a sostituire altrettante unità navali della flotta Amoretti che fin dalla loro entrata in esercizio, all’inizio degli anni ’90, operano nel Mare del Nord e nel Mar Baltico, svolgendo servizio di trasporto di prodotti chimici per una delle principali energy major internazionali.

I finanziamenti verranno erogati nell’arco dei prossimi 2 anni a copertura dei pagamenti concordati a stato avanzamento lavori con il cantiere cinese.
