

WATSON FARLEY & WILLIAMS CONSEILLE SOCIÉTÉ GÉNÉRALE SUR LE FINANCEMENT DE L'ACQUISITION DE RAFFLES LEASE PAR LE GROUPE ERMEWA

Le cabinet d'avocats Watson Farley & Williams (« WFW ») a conseillé Société Générale sur le financement de l'acquisition par le Groupe Ermewa de Raffles Lease Ptd. Ltd (« Raffles Lease ») et de son portefeuille d'actifs sous gestion comprenant plus de 14 000 conteneurs.

Etablie à Singapour, Raffles Lease a pour activité la gestion locative de conteneurs-citernes et était auparavant détenue par Buss Global Investment Holdings Pte. Ltd. Le Groupe Ermewa est un acteur majeur de la location de wagons et de conteneurs-citernes en Europe. Cette acquisition porte sa flotte à plus de 60 000 conteneurs-citernes et confirme son ambition de croître à l'international.
